Installation Instructions

Please read BOTH these Installation Instructions and the General Towing Instructions before attempting to install or operate this equipment.

- 1. Blue Ox® towing products and accessories are intended to be installed by Blue Ox® Dealers who are familiar with our products and have the equipment and knowledge to do "fit work". When necessary, Blue Ox® Dealers can be found at www.blueox.com or by contacting our Customer Care Department at (402) 385-3051.
- 2. Many Blue Ox® Baseplates are designed to use existing holes and hardware to mount the baseplate to the towed vehicle. Even though bolts are there, do not assume they are equate for baseplate mounting. Always use hardware supplied in the hardware kit or existing hardware specified in the Baseplate Installation Instructions.

Confirm the towability and pre-towing procedures for your vehicle with the owner's manual or contact the vehicle's manufacturer for specific towing procedures.

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

Important:

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do **NOT** substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor. Failing to follow and/or altering these installation instructions in either installation or required equipment will void the manufacturer's warranty. towing behind a non-motorized vehicle will void the warranty.



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Attachment Tabs: Motorhome mount tow bars are recommended for use with this baseplate. Due to the design of the removable tabs, the RangeFinderll, Adventurer, and Ambassador tow bars can not be used. The Acclaim tow bar may be used, but will not fold and store on the front of the vehicle. Adapters, except the BX8833 and BX88151, can not be used with this baseplate.

Installation Notes: The radiator cover, grille assembly, belly pan, fascia, coolant line bracket on passenger's side, air baffle and air dams are removed for installation. Reinstallation of the air dams is optional. If air dams are reinstalled, trimming of the air dams is required. Drilling is required.

The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturer's tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods or bending end plates.

The BX8869 Bulb and Socket Wiring Kit is recommended for this vehicle.

Installation Instructions:



 Remove three Phillips pushpins from radiator cover and lift to remove. Set pushpins and radiator cover aside to be reinstalled later.




 Using the 10mm socket, remove one metric bolt from upper grill assembly. Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Lift assembly to remove. Set bolts and grille assembly aside to be reinstalled later.

Handling of some cosmetic parts when installing this product may require the use of protective covers, rags, specialty tools, etc. to prevent damage.

Do not use the towed vehicle for storing luggage, equipment, etc. This may cause you to exceed the towing capacity of the tow bar, baseplate, and its accessories.

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
Remove one push pin from top of fascia on each side of hood latch. Set pushpins aside to be reinstalled later.



4. Remove one bolt just forward of the front tire, on the edge of fascia, using the 30 Torx socket (see white arrow). Remove one metric bolt from the wheel well using the 7mm socket (see grey arrow). Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.




 Remove one Phillips screw from edge of fascia, just inside wheel well. Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Set screws aside to be reinstalled later. (Some models may have this.)



 Using the 7mm socket, remove three metric bolts from the bottom corner of fascia - two silver (see white arrows) and one black (see grey arrow). Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.

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


7. Using the 7mm socket, remove two metric bolts from the bottom center of fascia Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.



 Remove five Phillips pushpins from the bottom of the belly pan. Set pushpins and belly pan aside to be reinstalled later.






11. Pull wheel well cover aside and remove three metric bolts from back side of fascia using the 10mm socket. Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Pull fascia forward to remove. Set bolts and fascia aside carefully to be reinstalled later.


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
10. On passenger's side, flatten the tabs around the lower coolant line bracket. Using the 10mm socket, remove one metric bolt from the bracket. Set bracket aside to be reinstalled later (a new bolt is provided for reinstallation). Follow coolant line up to fender well and release from the upper bracket. Move coolant line out of the way. Note: Some models may have a low emission pump on passengers side frame. Lift from top of the frame and move out of the way.



11. On the drivers side, behind the metal bumper, use the 8mm socket to remove one metric bolt from the air baffle. Set bolt aside to be reinstalled later.



12. Pull the front tab of the air baffle down and forward to release.




13. Between the back side of the air baffle and the wheel well, use the 8mm socket to remove two metric bolts. Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.

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
14 Using the 6mm socket, loosen the air baffle clamp. Disconnect electrical connection. Pull air baffle down and set aside.



15. Follow the air dam plastic (shown in photo) to above the metal bumper and use the flat screwdriver to remove two pushpins. Pull air dam forward to remove. Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Set air dams and pushpins aside to be reinstalled later.



16. Slide the baseplate onto the frame rails 1 1/2" back from the bumper bracket aligning the front air baffle hole with the front middle hole of the baseplate. Align the top edge of the endplate with the top edge of the frame rail and clamp in place using the large vise grips. Hold the fascia up to its original position and verify the convenience links, electrical rods and attachment tabs come through the fascia opening.



17. Using the baseplate as a template, drill four corner holes into the frame webbing with the 13/32" drill bit. Insert 3/8"-16 x 1 1/4" hex bolts into holes and tighten to the 1/4" lock washers and 3/8-16 hex nuts.

When using power drills be aware of the dangers of torque and drill bit length.

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18. On the passenger's side, reinstall coolant bracket to lower endplate hole. Put 1/4" flat washer on the 1/4-20 x 1" hex bolt and insert into hole and tighten to the 1/4" lock washer and 1/4-20 hex nut using the 7/16" socket. Do not attach the coolant line to the top bracket if it causes the line to rub against the baseplate. Models with a low emission device need to reposition the device with a wire tie.



19. Reinstall air baffle to middle endplate hole on driver's side with the existing bolts and clamp. If necessary, remove the rubber grommet from the bolt (see white arrow) to it to tighten properly.

Be sure that **ALL** electrical connections are plugged in properly and functioning **BEFORE** installing the fascia.

BE SURE TO USE LOCTITE® RED ON ALL BOLTS BEFORE TIGHTENING. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS ACCORDING TO THE TORQUE CHART ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS OR ON PAGE 3 OF THE BASEPLATE TOWING GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.

20. Reinstall air dams, fascia, belly pan, grille assembly, radiator cover, pushpins, bolts and screws. Note: Air dams may be left off vehicle or hold air dams just below original location and mark and trim the air dams to allow baseplate to fit.

Install the tow bar and safety cables according to the instructions provided in their packages. When demonstrating this to the customer, be sure to include all the contents and packages.

Do **NOT** substitute other devices if the tow bar pins and clips are misplaced.

If the baseplate is in an accident, it must be replaced. DO NOT use it again! An accident can cause unseen damage and using it again could result in more damage or serious injury. DO NOT use the baseplate if it is damaged or missing parts.

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General Information

- 1. Ensure that your product(s) are registered online at www.blueox.com. It is crucial to register your product(s) so that you may be alerted of product offerings, updates, upgrades, maintenance and safety bulletins, and/ or recalls.
- 2. It is the owner's responsibility to inspect all towing equipment for cracked welds, missing or worn parts and loose bolts before each towing trip. Be sure to use Loctite® Red on all bolts and tighten to the recommended specifications.
- 3. It is the owner's responsibility to hook up all towing equipment per manufacturer's instructions/recommendations.
- 4. Remove the attachment tabs when not in use (if applicable).

Notice To Baseplate Installer

- 1. It is YOUR responsibility to watch for:
 - Oil cooler and air conditioner lines
 - Electrical wires and hoses
 - Missing parts or attaching points on the frame
 - ** If the baseplate is improperly installed and is against a wire or hose, it could cause fluid leaks or electrical shorts some time after the actual baseplate installation.

Permanent Baseplate Safety Cable Installation

Permanent baseplate safety cables are strongly recommended when towing a vehicle with a tow bar. The principle function of the permanent baseplate safety cables is to prevent the towed vehicle from breaking loose in the event the connection between the frame of the towed vehicle and the baseplate fails or becomes disconnected. The cables must be connected from the baseplate to the frame rail or cross member of the vehicle's frame. The illustrations below show the possible arrangements recommended by Blue Ox®. Each permanent baseplate safety cable must have an adequate weight rating for the towing system. The weight rating of the two (2) cables together will not qualify.

Do not mount the permanent baseplate safety cables against wires, hoses or brake lines.

These permanent baseplate safety cables should remain installed as long as the baseplate is installed on the vehicle. Permanent baseplate safety cables are to be used in conjunction with, and NOT a replacement for legally required safety cables attaching the towed vehicle to the towing vehicle.
