

BLUE OX® 2011-14 Cadillac Escalade Platinum (Includes Hybrid) Installation Instructions

Please read BOTH these Installation Instructions and the General Towing Instructions before attempting to install or operate this equipment.

- 1. Blue Ox® towing products and accessories are intended to be installed by Blue Ox® Dealers who are familiar with our products and have the equipment and knowledge to do "fit work." When necessary, Blue Ox® Dealers can be found at www.blueox.com or by contacting our Customer Care Department at (402) 385-3051.
- 2. Many Blue Ox® Baseplates are designed to use existing holes and hardware to mount the baseplate to the towed vehicle. Even though bolts are there, do not assume they are adequate for baseplate mounting. Always use hardware supplied in the hardware kit or existing hardware specified in the Baseplate Towing Installation Instructions.

Confirm the towability and pre-towing procedures for your vehicle with the owner's manual or contact the vehicle's manufacturer for specific towing procedures.

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do NOT substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor. Failing to follow and/or altering these installation instructions in either installation or required equipment will void the manufacturer's warranty.



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Vehicle Weight: Be sure to confirm the weight of your individual vehicle before towing. Some models, depending on options and load, may exceed the weight rating of specific tow bars. Always insure both your tow bar and hitch are adequately rated for the vehicle's overall weight.

Tow Bar Adapters are NOT to be used with vehicles weighing over 5,000 lbs.

Installation Notes: The fascia, radiator cover and lower bumper support are removed and reinstalled during installation of the baseplate. Drilling is required. Trimming of the fascia is required.

The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturer's tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods or bending end plates.

The BX8848 Diode Wiring Kit is recommended for this vehicle.

Handling of some cosmetic parts when installing this product may require the use of protective covers, rags, specialty tools, etc. to prevent damage.

Do not use the towed vehicle for storing luggage, equipment, etc. This may cause you to exceed the towing capacity of the tow bar, baseplate, and its accessories.







1. Remove nine push pins from the radiator cover on the top side of the fascia. Set radiator cover and push pins aside to be reinstalled later.




Using a 10MM socket, remove six bolts from the fascia. Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later. Carefully remove fascia and set aside to be reinstalled later.



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


3. In front of the tire, with a 7MM socket, remove 2 bolts (white arrows). Also remove 2 push pins in front of the tire (gray arrows). Do this to both sides. Set bolts and push pins aside to be reinstalled later.



Using a 10MM socket, remove one bolt located underneath the fascia, directly in front of the tire (white arrow). Also, directly in front of the tire, remove 1 push pin (gray arrow). Do this to both sides. Remove lower bumper support and set lower bumper support, bolts and push pins aside to be reinstalled later.





5. Using existing front holes in frame and baseplate as a guide, slide the baseplate up to frame rail as shown in picture 5A. There are existing bolt holes to align baseplate (2 on driver's side, 1 on passenger's side). Insure baseplate is level. Clamp with large vise grips. Should existing bolt holes need to be drilled to accommodate baseplate, use 17/32" drill bit to accommodate the 1/2-13 x 1 1/4 hex bolts. Start with the front bolts referenced in pictures 5B and 5C (white arrows). Yellow is used on this baseplate for demonstrative purposes only.

Insert 1/2-13 x 1 1/4 hex bolts into the front holes of each side of the baseplate (gray arrows) with 1/2-13 hex nyl. ins. locking nut. Tighten bolts with Loctite Red.

> BE SURE TO USE LOCTITE® RED ON ALL BOLTS **BEFORE TIGHTENING. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS** ACCORDING TO THE TORQUE CHART ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS OR ON PAGE 3 OF THE BASEPLATE TOWING GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.



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At the bottom of the baseplate, drill with a 17/32" drill bit to accommodate the 1/2-13 x 1 1/4 hex bolt. Do this on both sides - confirm baseplate remains level. Insert 1/2-13 x 1 1/4 hex bolts into holes on each side of the baseplate with 1/2-13 hex nyl. ins. locking nuts. Tighten bolts with Loctite Red.





Drill remaining 2 holes on side plates of the baseplate with a 17/32" drill bit. Do this on both sides. Insert 1/2-13 x 1 1/4 hex bolts into holes on each side of the baseplate with 1/2-13 hex nyl. ins. locking nuts. Tighten bolts with Loctite Red.





8. Using a utility knife, cut out chrome webbing on the front of the fascia to accommodate baseplate. Do this on both sides.



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9. After chrome has been trimmed, on backside of fascia, trim plastic with utility knife as shown in 9A. Turn fascia over and trim second layer of plastic from fascia with utility knife (9B). Completed trimming shown in 9C.



10. Optional: To mount electrical connector (not provided), in the center, underneath the license plate frame at bottom of the fascia, with a 1 1/2" hole saw, drill through the bottom of the fascia frame as shown above. Insert electrical adapter. Using the adapter as a template, drill additional holes on each side to attach with the hardware.






- 11. Attach permanent baseplate safety cables to the provided convenience link on the baseplate (white arrow) The photo above shows the recommended installation of the cables to frame of vehicle (gray arrow). Additional options may interfere with suggested mounting; in this case, secure the cables to a solid piece of the frame as described in the instructions included with the permanent baseplate safety cables. Be sure the safety cables do not rub against any hoses or moving parts. Do this to both sides of the vehicle.
- 12. Reinstall lower bumper support, fascia, and radiator cover with existing bolts and push pins.

When using power drills be aware of the dangers of torque and drill bit length.



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13. **Optional:** With a 15MM socket, remove the driver's side bolt from the bellypan. Attach breakaway bracket into existing hole on bellypan using existing bolt (13A). Attach breakaway bracket to fascia with 1/4-20 x 3/4 hex bolt and 1/4-20 hex nyl. nut (13B).

DEALER or INSTALLER: Be certain the user receives the instruction sheets for their products. Be sure that ALL electrical connections are plugged in properly and functioning BEFORE installing the fascia.



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Install the tow bar and safety cables according to the instructions provided in their packages. When demonstrating this to the customer, be sure to include all the contents and packages.

Do **NOT** substitute other devices if the tow bar pins and clips are misplaced.

If the baseplate is in an accident, it must be replaced. DO NOT use it again! An accident can cause unseen damage and using it again could result in more damage or serious injury. DO NOT use the baseplate if it is damaged or missing parts.

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General Information

- 1. Ensure that your product(s) are registered online at www.blueox.com. It is crucial to register your product(s) so that you may be alerted of product offerings, updates, upgrades, maintenance and safety bulletins, and/ or recalls.
- 2. It is the owner's responsibility to inspect all towing equipment for cracked welds, missing or worn parts and loose bolts before each towing trip. Be sure to use Loctite® Red on all bolts and tighten to the recommended specifications.
- 3. It is the owner's responsibility to hook up all towing equipment per manufacturer's instructions/recommendations.
- 4. Remove the attachment tabs when not in use (if applicable).

Notice To Baseplate Installer


- 1. It is YOUR responsibility to watch for:
 - Oil cooler and air conditioner lines
 - Electrical wires and hoses
 - Missing parts or attaching points on the frame
 - ** If the baseplate is improperly installed and is against a wire or hose, it could cause fluid leaks or electrical shorts some time after the actual baseplate installation.


Permanent Baseplate Safety Cable Installation

Permanent baseplate safety cables are strongly recommended when towing a vehicle with a tow bar. The principle function of the permanent baseplate safety cables is to prevent the towed vehicle from breaking loose in the event the connection between the frame of the towed vehicle and the baseplate fails or becomes disconnected. The cables must be connected from the baseplate to the frame rail or cross member of the vehicle's frame. The illustrations below show the possible arrangements recommended by Blue Ox®. Each permanent baseplate safety cable must have an adequate weight rating for the towing system. The weight rating of the two (2) cables together will not qualify.

Do not mount the permanent baseplate safety cables against wires, hoses or brake lines.


These permanent baseplate safety cables should remain installed as long as the baseplate is installed on the vehicle. Permanent baseplate safety cables are to be used in conjunction with, and NOT a replacement for legally required safety cables attaching the towed vehicle to the towing vehicle.
