#### **Baseplate Installation:**



1. Slide baseplate onto tow hook housing so that the back slotted hole of the baseplate lines up with back hole on housing. Insert the one (1) 1/2" x 5" bolt with washers on the outside and two (2) spacers as shown. Leave loose at this time. Do this on both sides of the vehicle.







#### **Permanent Baseplate Safety Cable Installation**

Permanent baseplate safety cables are strongly recommended when towing a vehicle with a tow bar. Each permanent baseplate safety cable must have an adequate weight rating for the towing system. The weight rating of the two (2) cables together will not qualify.

Do not mount the permanent baseplate safety cables against wires, hoses or brake lines.

These permanent baseplate safety cables should remain installed as long as the baseplate is installed on the vehicle. Permanent baseplate safety cables are to be used in conjunction with, and NOT a replacement for legally required safety cables attaching the towed vehicle to the towing vehicle.
